

Attention Social Work Majors:

The online degree program in social work requires a secondary formal application prior to the completion of the field practicum. Formal application and acceptance is necessary for current students before they can complete the social work practicum and final 8 courses of the degree. All other courses can be completed prior to or after formal acceptance.

Current students will be identified by their advisor and invited to formally apply once they have complete 45 credit hours and the following courses: SW 280, Soc 204, Bio 100, Psy 105, and a GER math course. Students must also be registered for SW 301.

Most of our courses are offered in modules lasting eight weeks each. Module 1 typically lasts from August to October; Module 2 typically lasts from October to December. Module 3 typically lasts from January to March, and Module 4 typically lasts from March to May. BUonline students will also have the opportunity to take four week online courses in December and summer online courses that typically last from May to July.

Please note that some of our courses do last an entire semester, particularly most upper-division social work courses.
