WHY SHOULD STUDENTS GET A SOCIAL WORK DEGREE?

WHAT TOPICS ARE COVERED AS PART OF THE CURRICULUM?

Our curriculum includes Introduction to Social Work; Human Behavior in the Social Environment (including the entire lifespan); Cultural Diversity; Social Work Practice with individuals, families, and groups, as well as with agencies in the community; Social Welfare Policy; Research Methods and Research Statistics; and Field Practicum. We also offer subject electives including Social Work in Criminal Justice; Social Work and Aging; Death and Dying; Women at Risk; Ethical Considerations of Social Work Practice; Child Abuse and Neglect; and Child Abuse Interventions.

ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN HUMAN SERVICES

Human services is the study and provision of human and social services to individuals and communities. The Associate of Arts in Human Services prepares students for entry-level positions in a variety of human service agencies.

ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS

The online Associate of Science in Business at Brescia University provides students with an introduction to the basic business models and modern business practices. Students also learn skills needed to conduct business in a variety of organizations and environments.


ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN LIBERAL ARTS

Master of Social Work

For decades, Brescia University's School of Social and Behavioral Sciences has brought you leading education in the field of Social Work with their Bachelor degree completion program. Brescia University is now offering their Master of So-

cial Work (MSW) degree fully online.

Brescia University offers a one year advanced standing Master of Social Work Program for students who have completed a CSWE accredited Bachelor of Social Work program in the last five years. Brescia University also offers a two year full Master of Social Work Program for students who have completed a bachelor's degree in a field other than social work.

Master of Science in Management (MSM)

The Online MSM is a 2-year, 32 credit-hour program designed to provide early and mid-career professionals with enhanced skills and abilities to prepare them for social and ethical responsibility.

<u>Certificate in Accounting Program – Post-Graduate</u>

Brescia University offers an accelerated online certificate program in accounting that is designed specifically for persons who have already completed a bachelor's degree in another field. Those individuals who cannot participate in traditional classrooms can now take accounting courses online.
